 - A general discussion took place about the proposed timeline associated with the actual implementation and completion of a community wide trail project and supported a timeline far less than 10 years.
 - The Committee proceeded to review the proposed trails map and make final adjustments to a variety of trail sections, prior to Eric Pulling developing a revised version of the trails map for the presentation to the park board on 6-22-22.
