  - 6. A motion was made by Keith and seconded by Steve to recommend to the city council that the park and recreation board is in favor of the district using Hurley Park as a football practice field, on the condition that a separate written agreement be developed between the city and

# the district for use of said property, and for the parties to be in mutual agreement of the terms as contained therein.
