The Milbank Planning and Zoning Commission met for a regular meeting on Monday, December 5, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. in the Milbank City Council Chambers. A motion was made by Schmeichel and seconded by Ebsen to approve the minutes of the November 14, 2022, meeting. Motion carried 6-0.
